
FROM DAVIS COUNTY:


















Nominate a local volunteer and they could win \$3,000 for their charity!

Southern Iowa Electric Cooperative, Inc.

One advantage of belonging to a rural electric cooperative is receiving your share of Capital Credits. Any earnings left over after all expenses and/or reserves are paid are allocated back to members as Capital Credits. Capital Credits represent your share of the ownership and become part of the capital investment in your cooperative.
