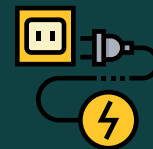

Spray Notice for Floris and Belknap

SIEC's 2026 efforts to control brush will focus on the **Floris** and **Belknap** Substation areas. **Notification letters were mailed to members July 2nd.** The method of control being utilized will be an environmentally safe herbicide applied to right-of-way locations by ProtecTerra. Starting in July, workers will begin selective, backpack-applied, low-volume foliar treatment of brush and small tree growth. This treatment uses a herbicide mixture that is absorbed through treated foliage. The application is intended to suppress or control treated brush and reduce regrowth in the following growing season. If you have questions or concerns in regards to the methods utilized in SIEC's brush management program, please contact our office at 800-607-2027.

- New Installation, Gas or Electric Replacement – \$1,050

Energy Star Heat Pumps

- Ground Source Heat Pump 19.1 EER – New Installation – \$750/ton
- Ground Source Heat Pump 19.1 EER – Replacement of indoor unit only – \$400/ton
- Air Source Heat Pump/Mini Split (Ducted) **Fossil Fuel Back-up Required** Min HSPF2=8.1 – New Installation – \$600/ton
- Air Source Heat Pump/Mini Split (Ducted) **Fossil Fuel Back-up Required** Min HSPF2=8.1 – Replacement – \$400/ton
- Mini Split (Ductless) **Cannot Have Electric Auxiliary Heat** – Energy Star Certified – \$300/condensing unit – *limit 2 condensing units per meter*

2. Check your seals on windows, doors and vents. Check for leaks to keep cool air in and hot air out.

4. Upgrade to LED lighting. LEDs use less energy and produce less heat.
